



By Virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries the Sixteenth day of October 1734. Surveyed unto George Trumbauer a tract of land Situate in Frederick Township in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup>. Beginning at a post in a line of Godlieb Hergers land thence by the same North West twelve perches and by vacant land the same course one hundred and one perches to a post in a line of Philip Totherak's land thence by the same and Vact land North East one hundred and fifty perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South East one hundred and Thirteen perches to a post in a line of George Haan Land thence by the same South west one hundred and fifty perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred acres with the usual allowance of six P. Cent
