



A Draught of a survey lying on Buffaloe CK (Washington County) call'd Independance containg 277 Ac<sup>s</sup> & 80<sup>ps</sup> executed Dec<sup>r</sup> 14<sup>th</sup> 1785 in pursuance of a Certificate, in these words.

" We the Commss<sup>rs</sup> for adjusting the claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohg<sup>a</sup> & Ohio-do hereby certify that Nathaniel - Templeton is entitled to four hundred Ac<sup>s</sup> of Land in the County of Ohio, Situ-ate on the Waters of Buffaloe, ~~to~~ to include his settlement made in the Year 1776, also a right in preemption to one Thousand Ac<sup>s</sup> adjoining thereto.

" Given under our Hands at Cox's Fort ye 8<sup>th</sup> of Feb. 1780 and in ye 4<sup>th</sup> Year of ye Commonweath
