



A Draught of a survey called Tweed Side lying on the waters of Buffaloe Cr in Washington County Contg. 408 Ac^s & 119 P^s with ye allow^{se} executed March 9th 1786 in Consequence of a Certificate in these words. "We the Commiss^{es} for adjusting the claims to unpatented Lands in ye Counties of Monongalia York^e & Ohio do hereby that Jn^o Tweed Ass^{ee} of Rowland Martin is entitled to four hundred Ac^s of Land in ye County of Ohio, situate on ye Waters of Buffaloe to include his Settlement made in the Year 1775.

Given under our Hands at Cox's Fort the 7th day of Feb^y 1780 and in ye 4th Year of ye Commonwealth.
