



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated (1754) Philadelphia on the fourth Day of July Anno.-1754, granted to Samuel Woodringer. The above described Tract of Land Situate in Whitehall Township, in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania. Containing Sixty Acres and 98 perches of Land together with the Usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads, was Surveyed for Peter Traxel, as also another Small Tract Adjoining to his other Land, Containing Eight Acres of Land with the usual allowance at Six per Cent for Roads, Was Surveyed for the Said Peter Traxel on the 25<sup>th</sup> Day of April Anno-1755.
