



In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 1760. I have caused to be surveyed on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of the same Month unto Sarah Wilkinson two Bank Lots of Ground in the City of Philad<sup>a</sup>, between Delaware Front Street & King Street & between Mulberry & Sassafras Streets, cont<sup>d</sup> in Breadth together 20 feet & in Length 45 feet. (one of which Lots is part of a Lot granted Thomas Peart, & contains 14 feet; the other is part of a Bank & Water Lot granted formerly to Thomas Holmes & contains 6 feet) Bounded Westward by Delaware Front Street, as<sup>d</sup> Northward by Ground of Anthony Wilkinson, Eastward by King Street & Southward by Ground of the Representatives of John Robins, dec<sup>d</sup> Nich<sup>o</sup> Scull. — —

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-seventh day of March 1907.
