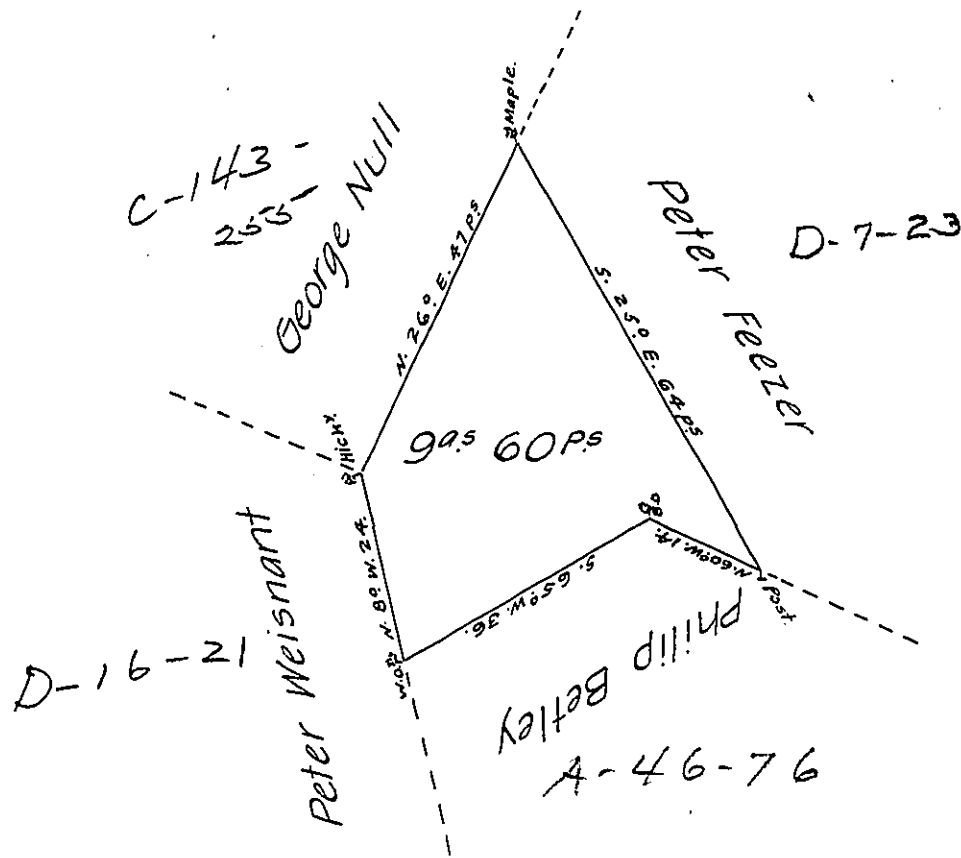

By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of June 1744, Surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of November 1761, to Henry Holler and Peter Fry, in Trust, for the Lutharian and Reform'd Congregation; the above Described Tract of Land Situate in Cocolico Township, Lancaster County. Containing Nine Acres and sixty perches and the Allow<sup>e</sup> of six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent  $\frac{1}{2}$ .
