



By Virtue of a Warrant of Resurvey Dated the 25<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1763. I Resurveyed for John Whitmore the above Discribed Tract of Land according to the old lines of Marked Trees and find it to Contain Five hundred and seventy Acres and Allowance of six <sup>per</sup> Cent for Roads &c Situate in Lampiter Township, in the County of Lancaster. Resurveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1763, by Peter Lukens. —
