



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July following on a certain Lot of ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general Plan of said Town. Number Eighty five containing in Breadth North and South Fifty seven Feet six Inches, and in Length East and West two hundred and thirty feet Bounded Westward by Broadway, Northward by Poakberry Street, Eastward by River Alley, and Southward by Lot Number Eighty six. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 9th day of September 1774 for Michael Troy Esq^r by Warrant dated the 8th Instant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February 1833, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty eighth day of February 1907.
