



Situate in Windsor township, Berks County. Surveyed for Thomas Starr, as appears from the Draft of James Scull late a Deputy Surveyor of Berks County, on an Application N^o 1457 dated May 3^d 1766, granted to said Thomas Starr, said to contain One hundred seventy six acres and a quarter & allowance &c. - being however the same land on which also a Warrant was granted to Henry Wirtemberg, for 25 acres, dated February 10th A.D. 1755, and on the 18th of March 1766. Surveyed for said Starr, as appears by an endorsement on said Warrant; now Surveyed for John & Jacob Hoffman, laid down agreeably to the present position, and found to contain but One hundred and Seventy one acres and a half with allowance of 6th C^t

February 16th 1830.
