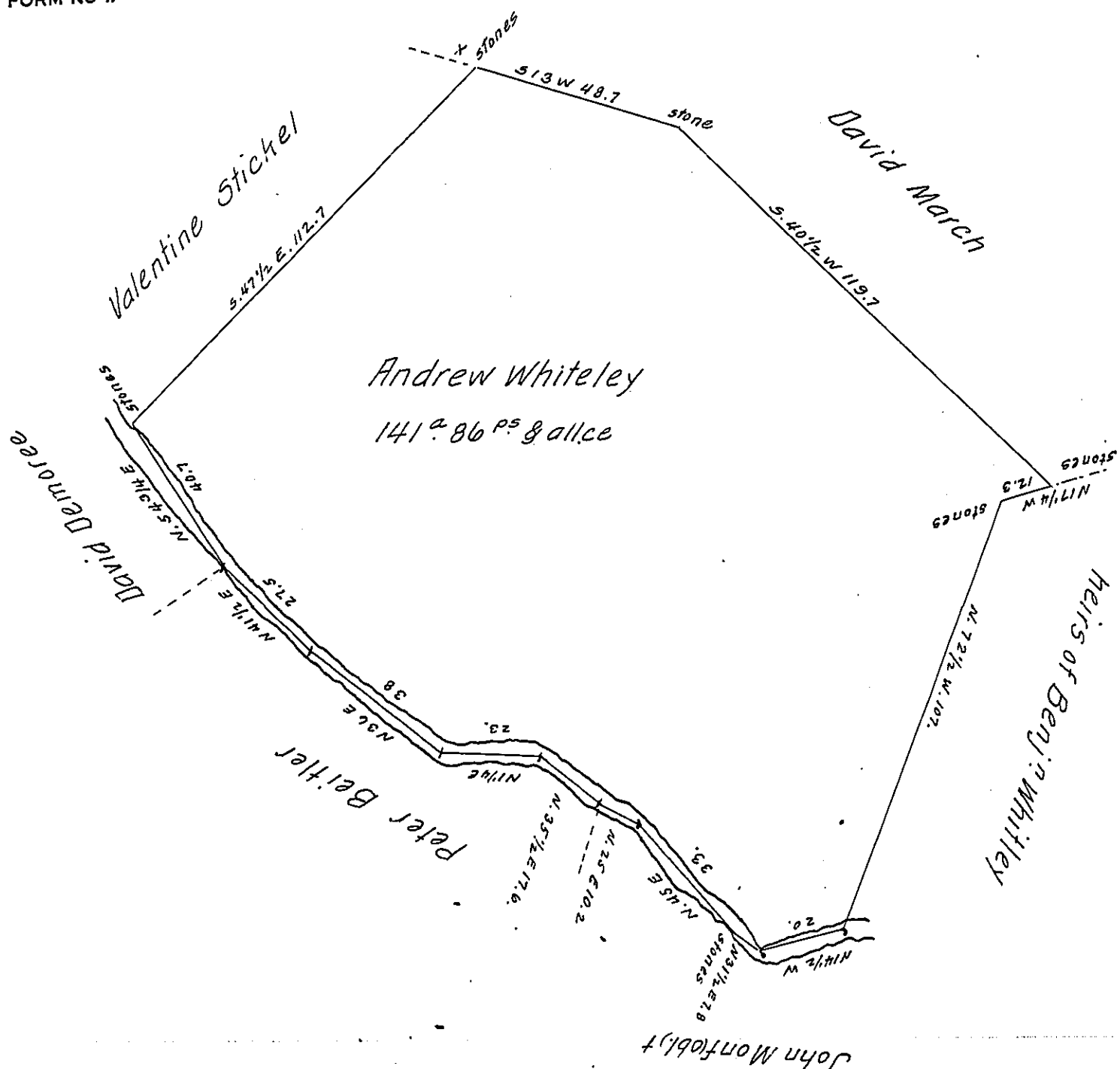


FORM NO 1.



Situate in Mount Pleasant Township Adams County, Surveyed October 24<sup>th</sup> 1810. In pursuance of a warrant granted to Andrew Whiteley for 140<sup>a</sup> dated August 30<sup>th</sup> 1809. Containing one hundred and forty one acres eighty six perches & allce, inside of warrant the date is Sept<sup>r</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> 1810.
