



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 12<sup>th</sup> day 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Andrew Watson for 400 Acres of Land Dated the tenth day of February 1794. Adjoining John Denniston to the Eastward and on the North Side of Conaquesing Creek North and West of the River Ohio. Called Sandy. Containing four hundred and thirty Six Acres and three quarters together with the Usual Allowance of Six p<sup>c</sup> Cent.
