



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 4<sup>th</sup> April 1792 Survey<sup>d</sup> the 31<sup>st</sup> Decem-  
ber 1794 to Esther Weiss the above described tract of Land situate on  
Mud-y Run between the two Shingle Roads about half mile from Jacob Weiss  
Sawmill in the County of Northampton, Containing four hundred and thirty  
five Acres forty five perches and the allowance of Six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent  $\frac{1}{4}$ .
