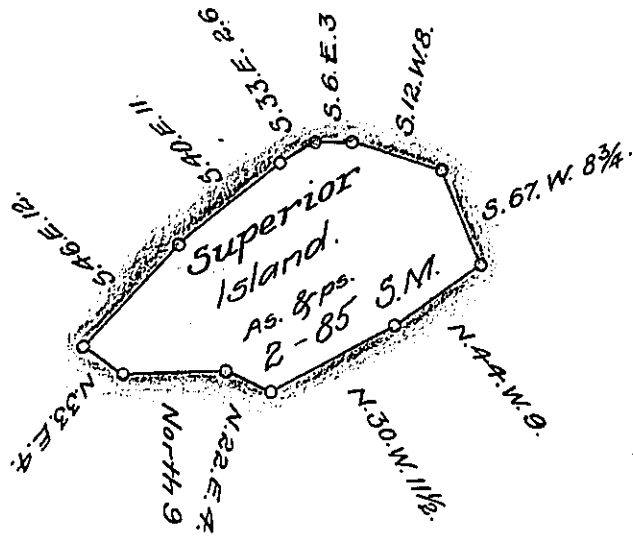

A Draught of an island situate in the River Susquehanna in Conestogoe township in the County of Lancaster called Superior Island about three yards from eastern shore, between Conestogoe & Burkholders Island reaching with the lower end near to Eshelmans falls and within sight of Israel Nestleroads Island & a short distance from Ludwig Urban and Jacob Kisslys Island containing two acres & eighty five perches strict measure, Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated the 11th day of February 1817 granted to John Yenser and John Kindig.
