



A Draft of a tract of land situated in Hopewell Township York County Pennsylvania containing all together 120 acres 75 perches and allowance - The parts marked "A" containing respectively 116 acres 09 per. and 2^{ac} 56 perches being parts of a tract of 208⁹⁶/₁₀₀ acres originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant for 200 acres granted to William Wills dated Aug. 18th. 1749 - Assigned to John Smith. - The part marked "B" being part of a tract of 39 acres and allowance - originally surveyed on the 6th day of January 1786 for James McDonald in pursuance of a warrant dated June 29th. 1785. Resurveyed the above March 16th. 1864 for John & Henry Harshner and John Logan - the present owners who desire to procure a patent for the same.
