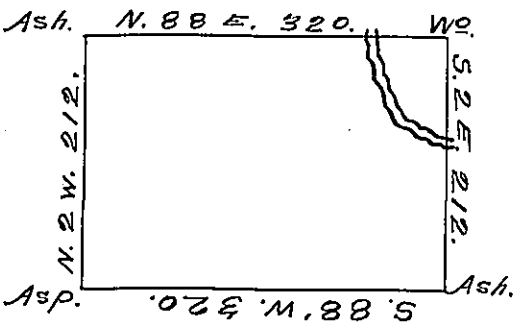


West Boundary of Pennsylv<sup>a</sup>.
