



Situate in Washington, formerly Warrington township, York County, Containing forty-eight Acres and one hundred and ten perches and Allowance. Being part of 105 As. & 146^{rs} and Allowance, Surveyed February 23, 1768, in pursuance of Application No. 3908, for 200 acres granted to William Webb, bearing date the 18th day of June 1767, And now, at the request of Joseph Hershey, A.B. Renoll and Jacob Stickel, the present owners, the part above within the lines shaded with yellow, is divided from the original Tract and returned for Confirmation. June 17, 1867.
