By virtue of a warrant dated the twenty-third day of June A.D. 1865, and to me directed, I surveyed the eighth day of July 1865 for James W.J. Ward the above described improved tract of land containing one hundred and thirty-two acres and eighty perches and allowance of six per cent, situate in Jenks township Forest County Pa. being the north-western portion of a larger tract of land containing 303 acres and 110 perches, and allowance of which this piece now located and returned is a part, being bounded and described as above, and improved since March 1848.
