



Draft of a tract of land containing 13 Acres 109 Perches and allowance of six per cent. for Roads &c. Situate in Saltlick Township Fayette County. Surveyed the 28th day of October A.D. 1871 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James M. Ullery for 15^{cs} dated the 12th day of April A.D. 1871. About one half of this tract is cleared but no buildings on it except obnces. The warrantee of this tract died this fall and Henry M. Ullery ob-tered on his Estate. Jacob Ullery Caveats the acceptance of this Survey claiming that this land belongs to the estate of his father, a part of it is enclosed in Jacob Ullery's field as represented by the dotted line and he desires to be heard before the issuing of the patent.
