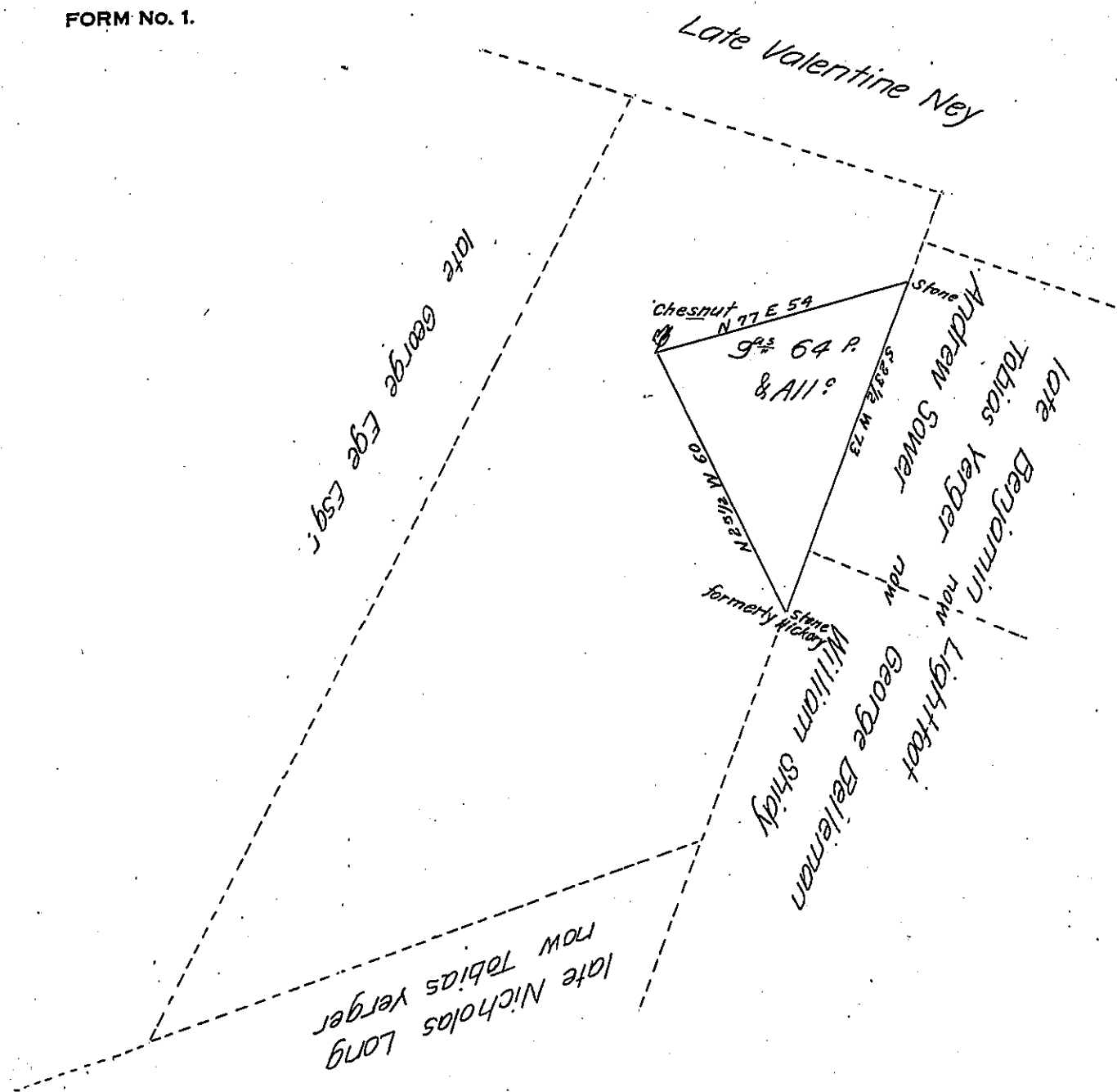


FORM NO. 1.



Situate in the Township of Upper Tulpehocken (formerly Tulpehocken) Berks County, Containing Nine Acres and Sixty four perches and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. being part of 57 1/2 acres and allowance. Originally surveyed to David Bright by virtue of an Application N<sup>o</sup> 55 dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August 1765. Resurveyed the above for David Unger October 24<sup>th</sup> 1864.
