



The above Described
 Parcels of Land containing
 33 a. & 140 p. & 9 3/4 a. & allowance at the
 rate of 6 a per Cent; were survey'd for James Walker, (In Pursuance of a
 Warrant granted to his Father Isaac Walker bearing Date the 3rd day
 of May 1765.) a former Survey having been made on the same Warrant,
 which interfered with a prior Warrant & Survey for Geo. Churchman, &
 was judged, & the matter in dispute settled by two men appointed by
 the Board of Property, by a minute thereof Dated the 28th. of June 1774.
 the three lines A.B.C. are the boundaries fixed between said Surveys;
 the 9 3/4 a above described was a vacancy including part of a Barren-hill left out of
 the adjacent Surveys which James requested to have added, in hopes it might be in-
 cluded with the other in one Patent. It is Situate in Little Britain Township Lancaster Coun-
 ty. The above certify'd in Consequence of an order from the Surveyor Generals office
 Dated 30th. of April last, to me directed Witness my Hand the 16th. 5mo. 1789
