 of land dated the 29th day of May 1794

There is 40 to 50 acres cleared, two log dwelling houses, a Barn
 stables &c. appears as if it had been occupied for 40 years or more.
 it is also necessary to note, that the land is in Saltlick, which was
 a part of Bullskin township originally.
