



By virtue of a Warrant granted to Philip Weiser dated the 19th day of March A. Dom. 1759 there was resurveyed on the 27th of May 1807 (by Henry M. Richards then Deputy Surveyor) unto George Ege, Esquire, in right of the said Philip Weiser the above described tract of land situate in Heidelberg township, Berks County, containing ninety five acres and the allowance of six per cent &c.
