



By virtue of a Warrant granted to Benjamin Wallace dated the 20th of August 1814 there was surveyed on the 28th day of May A. Dom. 1819 (by Henry M. Richards for John V. Epler then Deputy Surveyor) unto George Ege, Esquire, in right of the said Benjamin Wallace the above described tract of land situate in Heidelberg township, Berks County containing five acres and ten perches and the allowance of six per cent &c.
