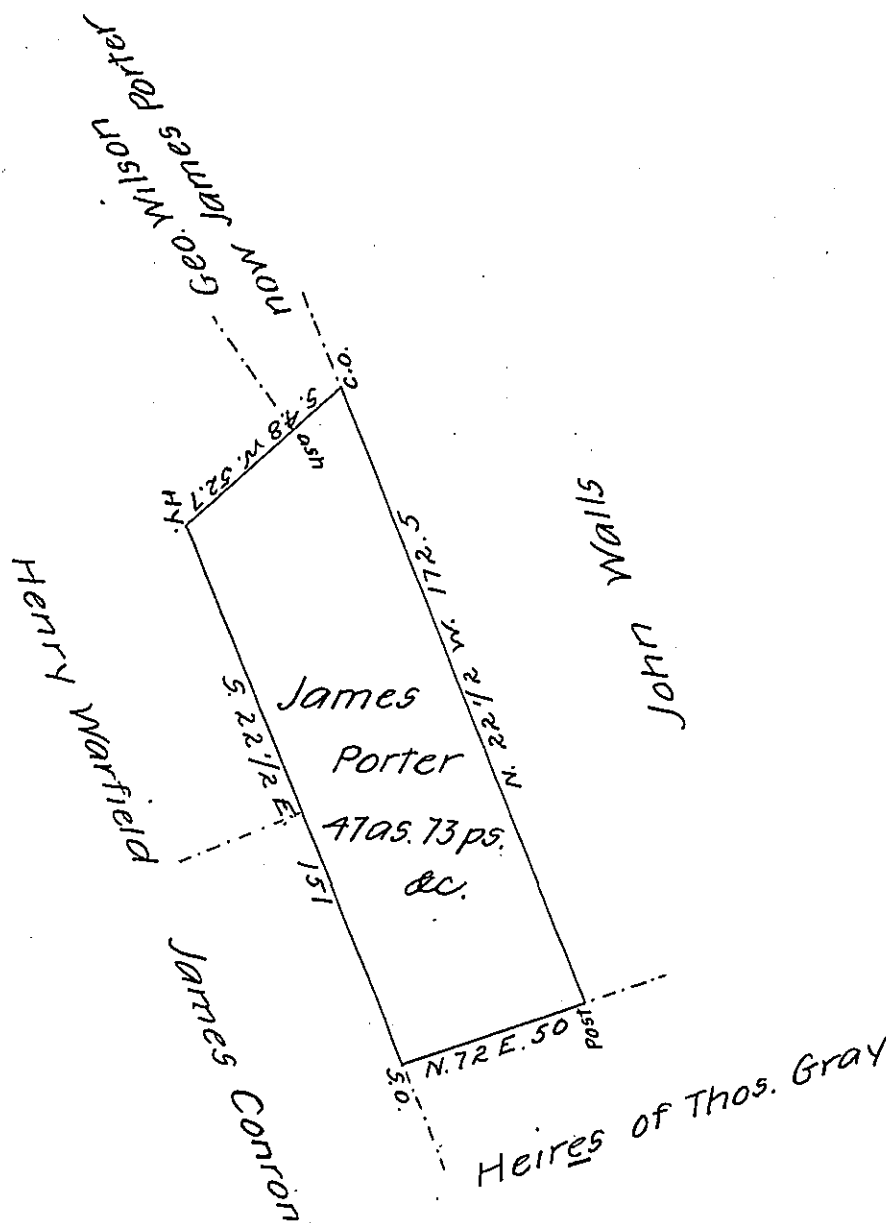

 ever Executed upon the ^{ground} And to compleat a Title from the
 Commonwealth a Warrant Issued to James Porter 31st Augs^t 1837
