



A draught of a tract of land called — situate on Bald Eagle Creek about a mile below the nest in the County of Cumberland surveyed the 18th day of July 1769 for Charles Worthington Junr. In pursuance of his application N^o 96 dated the 3^d day of April 1769 containing two hundred & seventy one acres & allowance of six acres per cent for roads &c.
