A draught of a tract of land called — situate on the easterly side of the north east branch of Susquehanna River adjoining land granted to James Thompson by warrant dated the 10th day of December 1773. above Mashapping — in the County of Northumberland containing three hundred and thirty seven acres and three quarters of an acre besides the usual allowance of six P cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 19th day of September 1774 for Thomas Walker in pursuance of a warrant dated 23^d day of December 1773
