



A draught of a tract of land called Good Luck situate on the north side of the Bald Eagle Creek about three miles below the Nest in Bald Eagle Township in the County of Northumberland surveyed the first day of June 1784 for Stophle Reigart by virtue of an application bearing date th-3<sup>d</sup> of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 1367 containing two hundred and ninety eight acres & allowance of six PG<sup>t</sup> for roads &c.
