



Draught of three pieces of Land situate in Maxatawney Township Berks County, Containing one hundred Acres & ninety five perches & the allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. No 1 being part of a larger Tract of sixteen acres & one hundred & fifty six perches & all surveyed to Nicholas Harmony in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 1<sup>st</sup> September 1746 No 2 being part of a larger tract of twenty nine acres & sixty four perches & allowance surveyed to Nicholas Harmony in pursuance of a Warrant dated 19<sup>th</sup> day of Decem: 1750. No 3 being part of a larger tract of Ninety three acres & one hundred and fifty three perches & allowance survey'd to Nicholas Harmony in pursuance of a warrant dated the 16<sup>th</sup> of May 1753. Resurvey'd & divided the 16<sup>th</sup> April 1810.
