



The draft of land in dispute between And<sup>y</sup> Myer & Christopher Walter Situate in Greenwood Township Cumberland County the whole was surveyed the 30<sup>th</sup> December 1803 on a warrant granted to Christopher Walter Dated Decemb<sup>r</sup> 14<sup>th</sup> 1803 And<sup>y</sup> Myer Claims the part No. 1<sup>st</sup> & Contains Sixty two acres & one hundred & seventeen perches and allowance; I believe that Walter Claims the whole the line S. 89. E. 118 perches was run the 3<sup>rd</sup> June 1804 in Consequence of an order of the Board of Property Dated May 7<sup>th</sup> 1804 ordering me to show the Claims of the parties which I have done as near as I can.

Landisburg Sept. 29<sup>th</sup> 1874.
