



Draft of a tract of land situated in Minzula township Warren County, South and East of the Allegheny River and Conewango Creek containing Two Hundred and forty nine Acres & Eighty perches surveyed the 28th day of May A.D. 1840 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Lansing Wetmore & Benjamin Bartholomew bearing date the 23^d day of July 1836 and assigned to John English the 31st day of March 1837 being part of the land described in said Warrant No. 18 adjoining One hundred forty eight Acres & eleven perches situate in Hamilton township McKean County surveyed on the same Warrant the 27th day of October 1836.
