



Situate in West Township Huntingdon County about half a mile below Dorsey's Forge containing one hundred & twenty seven acres one hundred & twenty six Perches and the usual Allowance for Roads. Surveyed the 3^d day of April 1802. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 19th day of March 1802.
