



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Clover Meadow situate on the South side of the West Branch of Susquehanna about six or seven Miles below the Mouth of the Chest Creek being the third Bottom below it and about a Mile and an half below Land of Henry Kepele the younger in the County of Bedford Containing two hundred and eighteen Acres and an half Acre and the usual Allowance of Six p Cent. for Roads &c. Surveyed the 28th Day of June 1773 for Lewis Weiss in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to him Dated the 12th Day of May in the same year.
