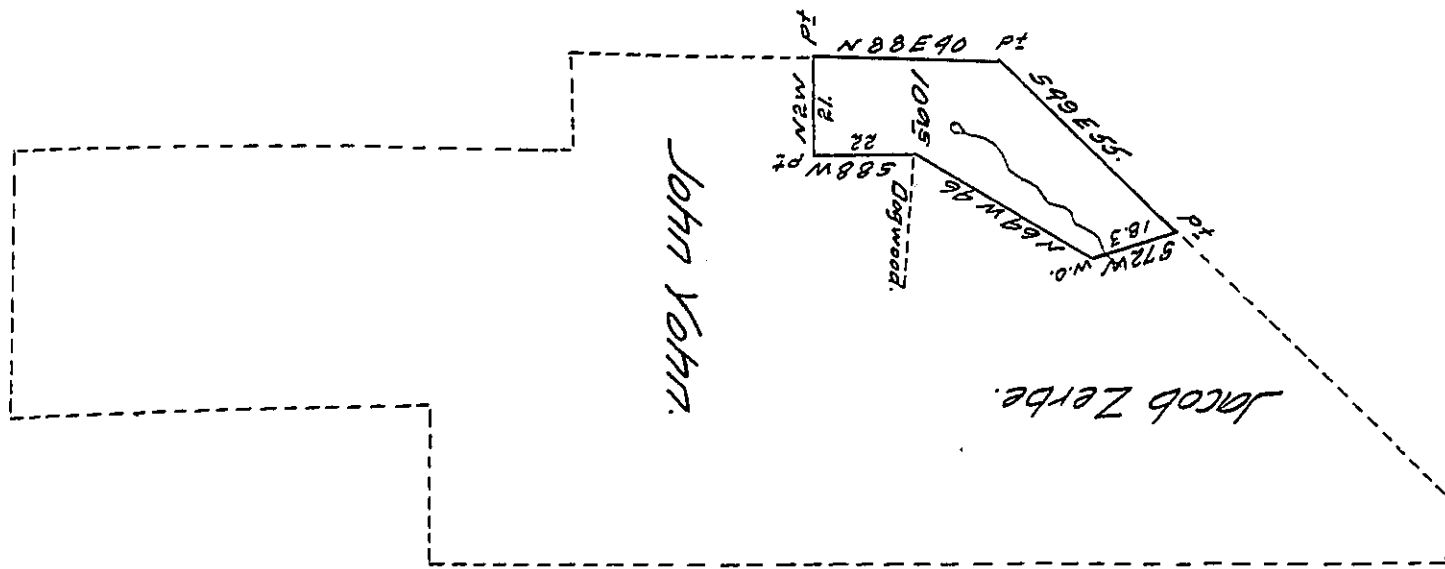


Robert Taylor
