



Situate in Greenwich township Berks County, Originally surveyed in pursuance of two Warrants; one of which dated the 11<sup>th</sup> January 1793 granted to George Adam Zettlemyer, the other of them dated February 28<sup>th</sup> 1826 granted to Thomas Boyd both of which warrants vested in Keim, Jones & Co. and the said surveys interfering with each other, upon Petitioning the Board of Property representing the facts an order of Resurvey was granted bearing date the twenty third day of September 1828. In pursuance whereof the above described tract of land was Resurveyed, containing two hundred and thirty four acres and a half, and allowance of 6 p Ct.
