



Situate in Manahan Township in the County of York (late part of the County of Lancaster. Containing as above set forth 95^a & 22^{rs} perches and the usual allowance of 6 per Cent &c. Originally surveyed by Thomas Armor late D.S. under George Stereson late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 100^a granted to Henry Wilson bearing date the 22^d day of October A.D. 1742. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of Land by the said Thomas Armor on the 22^d day of August A.D. 1755. And now at the request of the owners the Heirs of Samuel McMullen deceased, the above has been calculated, examined and found to be correct, and at their request returned for Confirmation the 3^d day of March Anno Domini 1817 per Jacob Spangler D.S.
