



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate on Sugar Run about one mile from the mouth thereof on the Westerly side of the River Susquehanna in the Township of Asylum Bradford County containing Four hundred and seven acres and ~~the~~ ninety five perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads, said to have been originally surveyed for William Williams ^{in the year 1793} by Jacob Hart as an assistant to Joseph J. Wallace late Deputy Surveyor. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 13th day of August 1792. The out lines of four tracts of which the above named is one appear to have been made about that time.

Examined on the ground & Resurveyed the 2^d day of July 1816 ~~at~~ in pursuance of the said Warrant of William Williams Jan. 7th 1818 by Jonathan Stevens D.S.
