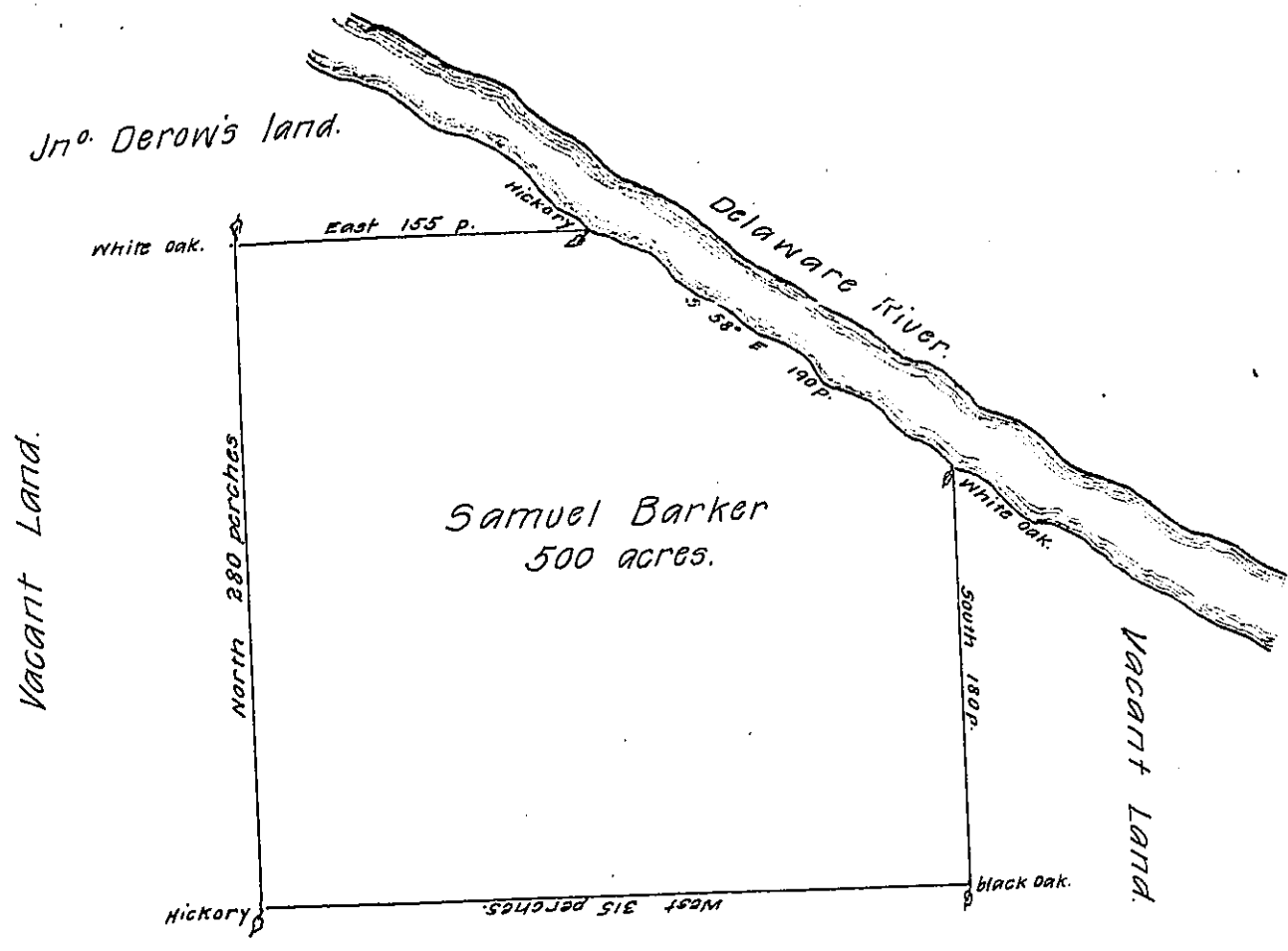

VACANT LAND

By Virtue of a warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing date the 24<sup>th</sup> day of the 6<sup>th</sup> month Anno Domini 1715 To lay out unto Samuel Barker one thousand acres of land, Surveyed & laid out unto the sd. Samuel Barker a tract of land upon Delaware River in the County of Bucks. Beginning at a white oak by the sd. River, from thence extending south by vacant land one hundred and eighty perches to a black oak, Then west by vacant Land three hundred & fifteen perches to a Hickory Tree, Then again by vacant Land North two hundred & eighty perches to a white oak in John Derow's Line, Then by the sd. John Derow's Land east one hundred & fifty five perches to a Hickory tree by the aforesd. River, Then down the sd. River south fifty eight degrees east one hundred & ninety perches to the place of Beginning containing five hundred acres, Surveyed & laid out the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the 2<sup>d</sup> month 1716, Certified under my hand the day & year aforesd.
