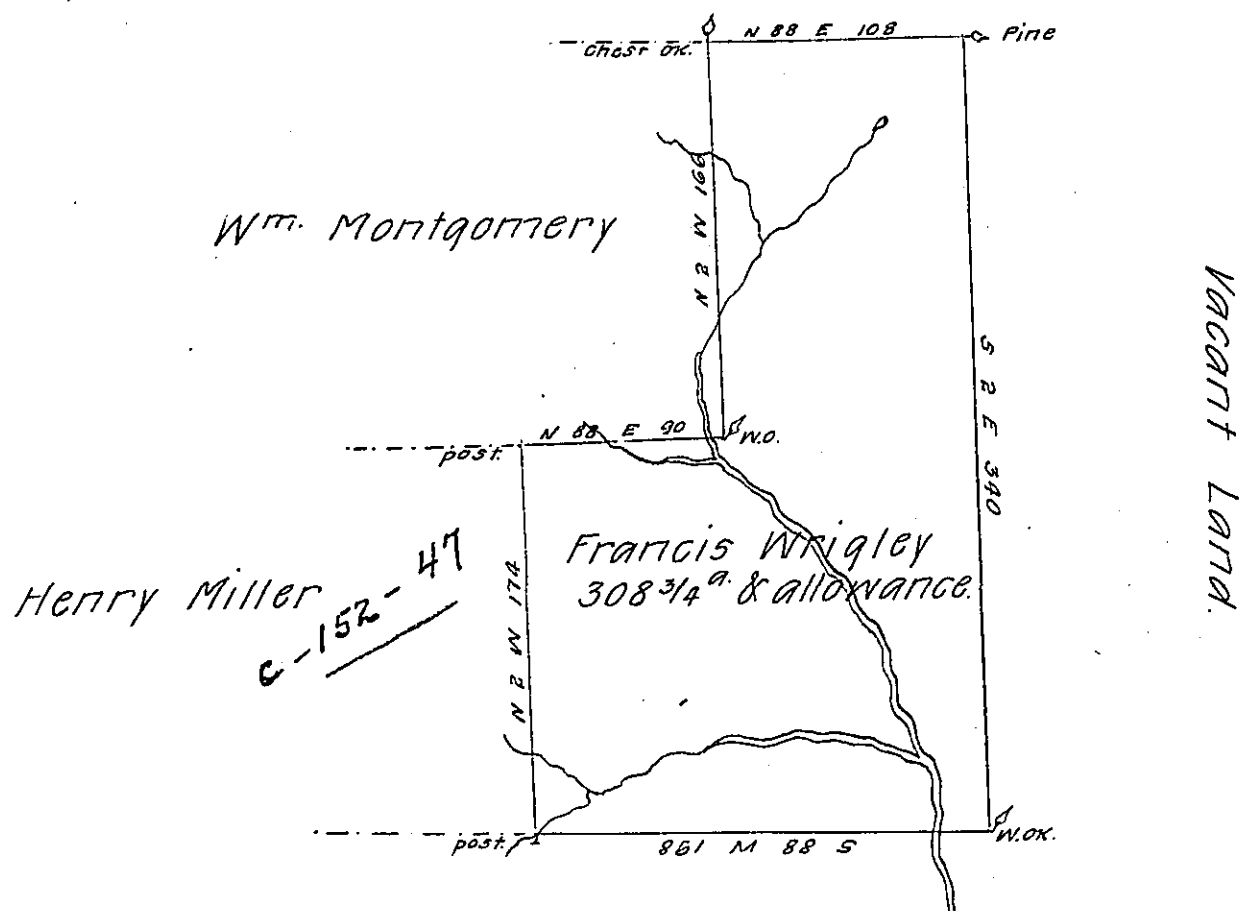

VACANT LAND

A draught of a tract of land situate on the waters of Little Fishing Creek adjoining land of William Montgomery in the County of Northumberland, Surveyed in the year 1774 by Charles Lukens, which appears by his field works, in the Hand Writing of Jonathan Lodge, Assistant to said Lukens at that time & resurveyed by me agreeably to the old lines on the 14th day of January 1791, for Francis Wrigley in pursuance of his warrant bearing date the 29th day of November 1774, containing three hundred & eight acres & three quarters with the allowance of six P. Cent for roads &c.
