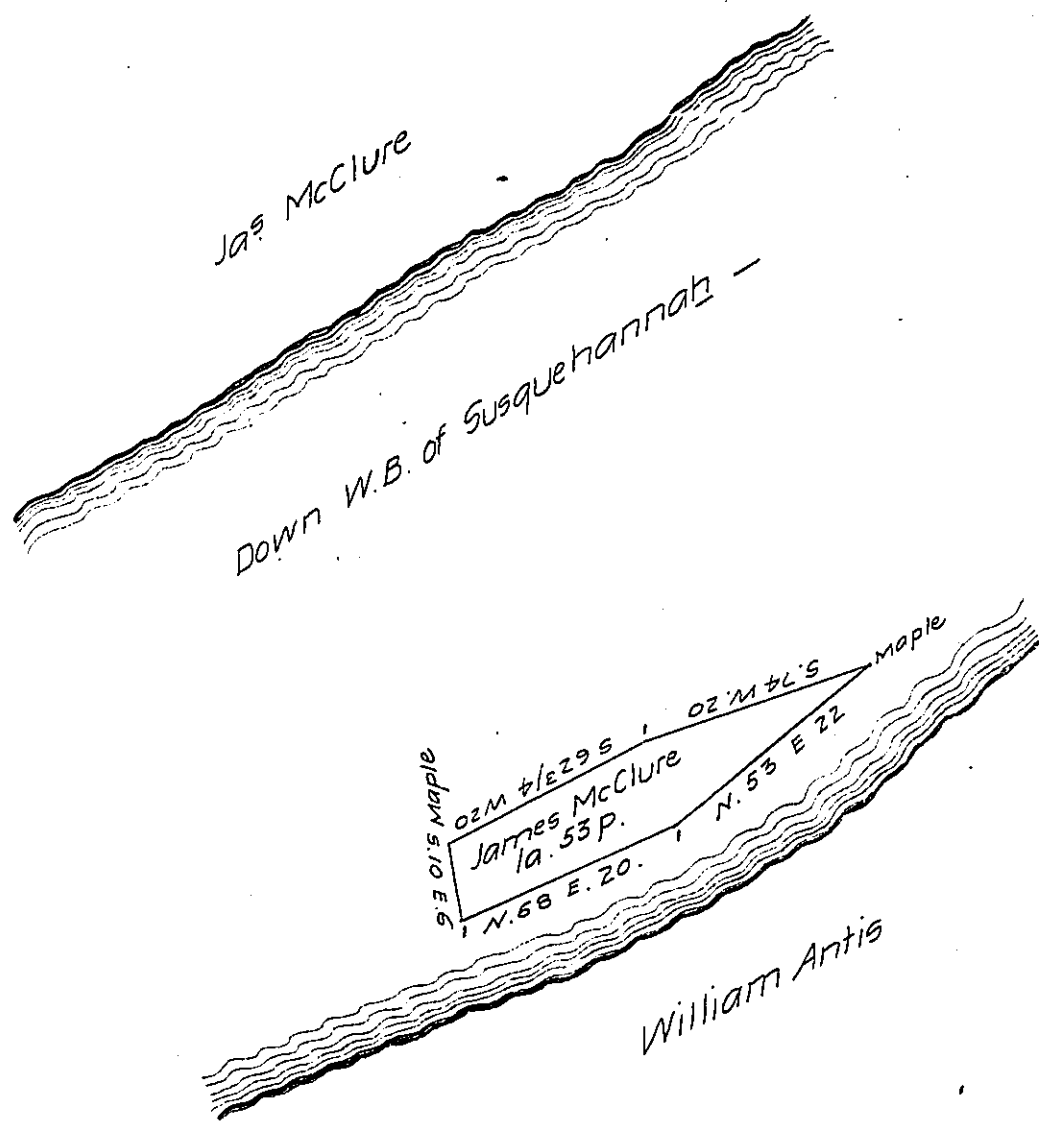


FORM NO 1.



Surveyed the above described Island for James McClure in right of assignee John White on the 2d day of October 1815 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to White on the 21st day of February 1815. Containing one acre & fifty three perch - Strict Measure. Situate about six perch from the South bank of the West Branch of River Susquehanna & about one mile below the mouth of pine creek opposite land of James McClure on the North Side of the River and land of Wm. Antis on the South, in Wain Township, Lycoming County.
