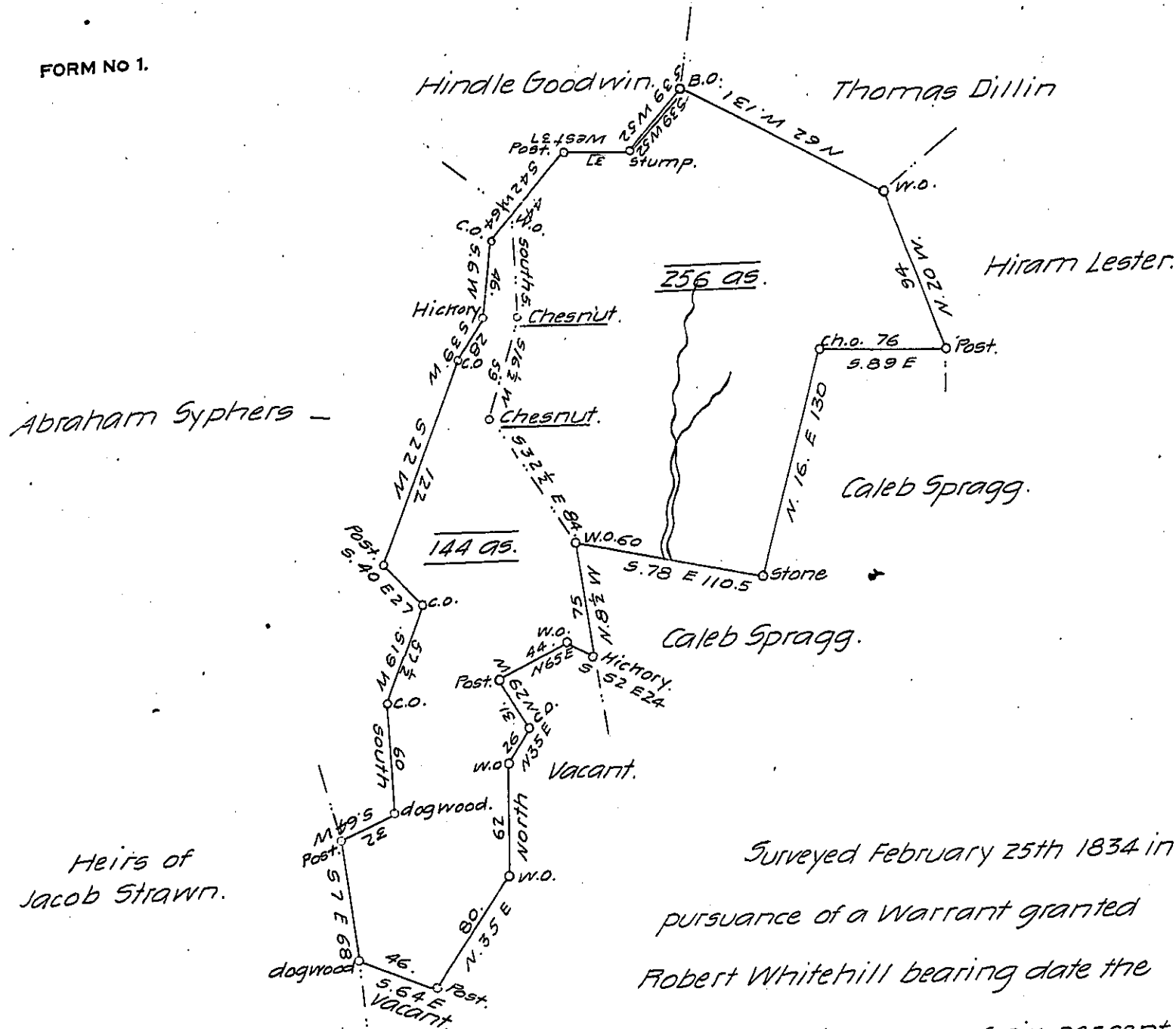

Surveyed February 25th 1834 in
pursuance of a Warrant granted
Robert Whitehill bearing date the

4th day of May 1829 containing 400 acres and allowance of six per cent
for Roads &c situate on the head of Roberts run in Waye township (once
Whitely) in the County of Greene. John Fordyce D.S.

To Jacob Spangler Esquire Sur. Genl. of Pennsylvania.

N.B. the part of this Survey south west of the dotted lines laps on Abraham
Syphers survey. I give the number of acres free of the interference & also the cour-
ses and distance that after the suit is ended a Patent may issue according to
decision of Court. I delayed the return of Mr. Syphers survey for years in hope the
claimants would compromise, but I cannot effect that object.

I cannot give the date of the Settlement on the above survey, the first knowl-
edge I had of the farm was about 30 years past. I then survey 100 acres off
the tract that was sold by Alexis Jackson to Caleb Spragg, the settlement
then appeared to have been made some 10 or 12 years.

P.S. does not close exactly, land very steep.

conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg,
