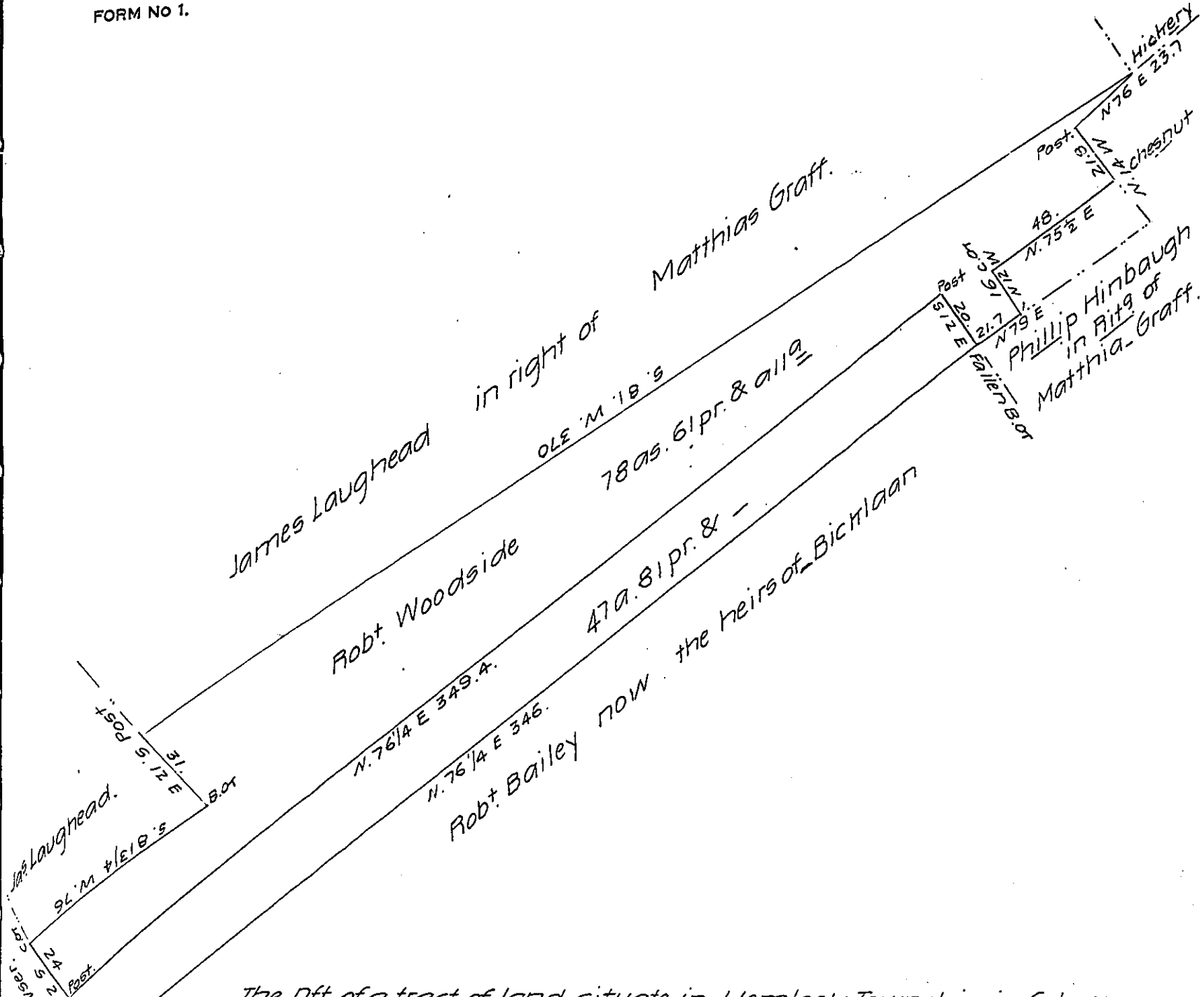


FORM NO 1.



The Dft of a tract of land situate in Hemlock Township in Columbia County surveyed unto Robert Woodside the 10th day of August 1818 by virtue of his warrant dated 16th July 1818. Containing (exclusive of what is included within the colered lines) Seventyeight acres and sixty one perches and the usual allowance. The warrant was intended to include the land within the colered lines but the heirs of owners of Robert Bailey, but contends and alleges that they have a right to have their distance which would extend beyond the black oak as represented by the Colered lines, the colered line includ. forty seven acres & eight one perche and the allowance Thos Woodside D.S.
