Draft of a tract of land situate in St. Thomas township (formerly Peters township) Franklin County, containing twenty nine acres one hundred & three perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. which was surveyed the 23d of June 1789 by Matthew Henderson Esqr. then D.S. on a Warrant granted Thomas Waddle for 25 as. of land joining his other land in Peters township, dated the 12th of June 1750. Certified the 18th of April 1830. In pursuance of a Contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights &c.
