



The above is a Draught of a Survey made 2nd day of September 1817 in pursuance of Warrant granted James Scott bearing date the 16th day of December 1811 containing 440 Acres and allowance of 6 per cent for Roads. Situate in Franklin Township on the South fork of Tenmile Creek called "Fortunate."
