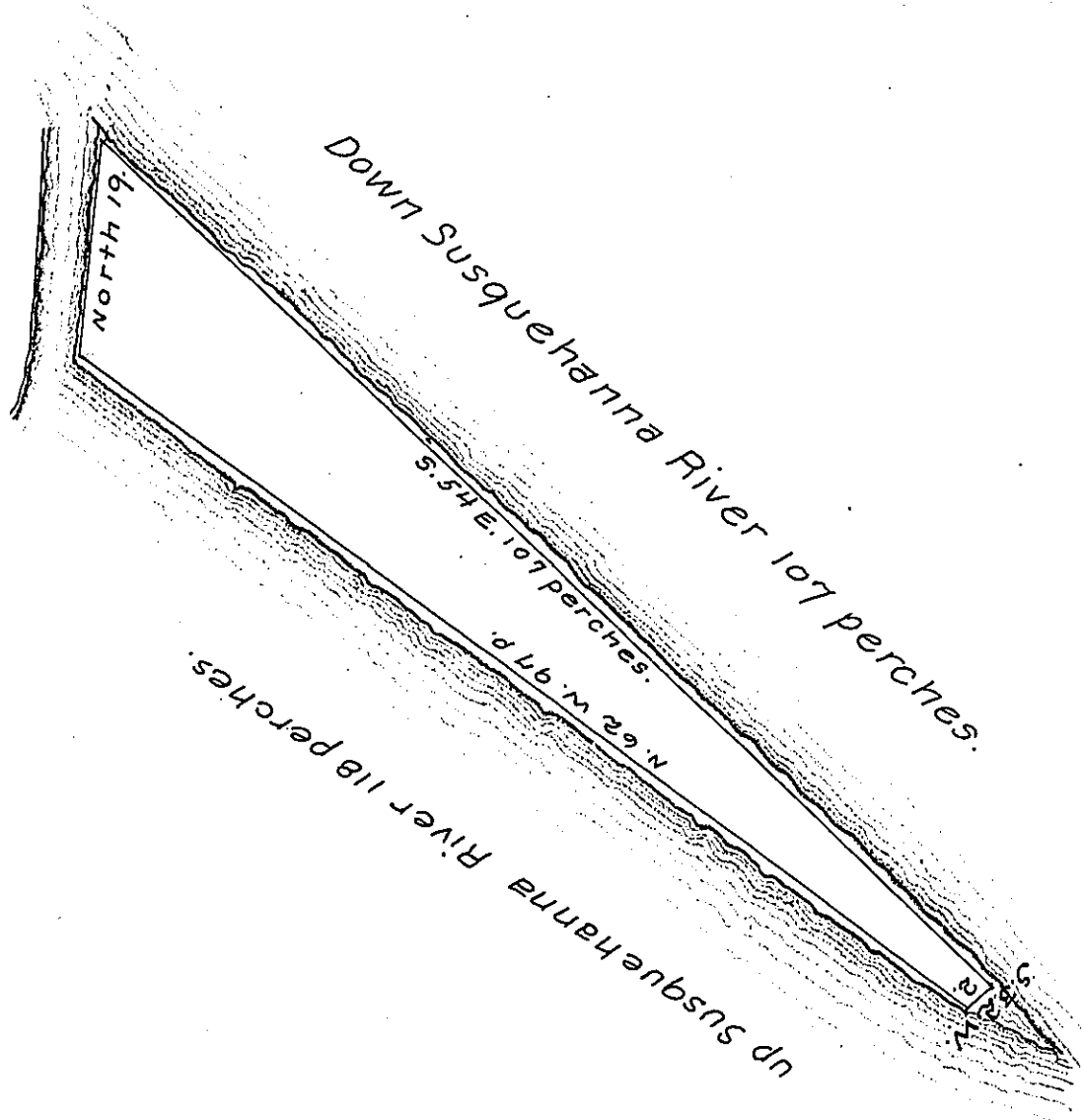


Another Island of Michael Simpsons.
