



Situate in Fairview Township (late Newbury township) in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 130<sup>as</sup> & 126 perches and allowance, Being part of a larger tract of 195<sup>as</sup> and allowance which was Originally Surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of September 1765, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Arthur Smith bearing date the 2<sup>d</sup> day of June A.D. 1762. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land by Jacob Spangler late D.S. on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of August 1809, and now at the request of Peter Drawbach the present owner the same has been calculated examined and found to be correct, and returned for Confirmation March 2<sup>d</sup> - 1820.
