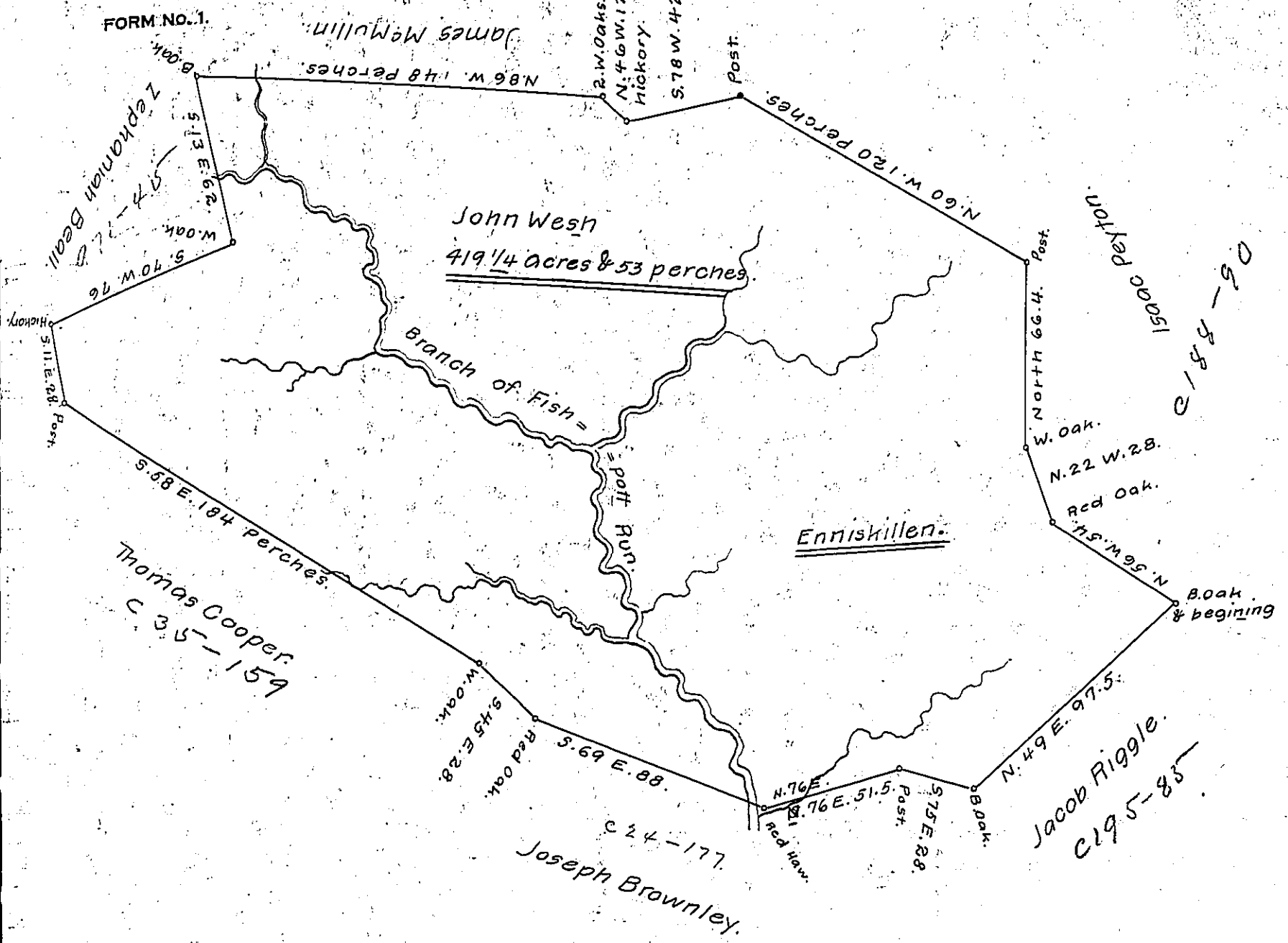

 allowance of 67 Cent Surveyed (for John Welsh Assignee of Christian Hames)
 March the 29th 1785 in pursuance of a Certificate from the Virginia surveyor
 "in the following words"

Christian Hames produced a Certificate from the Commissioner of
 Monongahela, Yohogany & Ohio for 400 Acres of Land on a Branch of the
 Fishpott Crawford's Creek, to include his Settlement made in 1774 and to
 include Improvements made on the same by Hugh M^r Mullin Dated 24th
 January 1780 and Enter the same
