



The above described tract of six acres and twenty perches and allowance of six per cent (proportional) for Roads &c is part of a larger tract of 140<sup>ac</sup> & 44<sup>ps</sup> & allowance, situate in Guilford Township Franklin County (formerly Cumberland) which was surveyed the 24th. of April 1798, in pursuance of an order of survey Granted to William Gass, bearing date the 24th. of November 1766, No 1929 surveyed and laid off the above part for Jacob Wisler the 26th. April 1822.
