



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July following for Joseph Duchee on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Eighty Six. Containing in Breadth North and South on Fawn Street Sixty feet and in Length East and West Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Westward by Fawn Street. Northward by Lot Number One hundred and Eighty five, Eastward by Meadow Alley, and Southward by Lot Number One hundred and Eighty Seven. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January 1775 for Joseph Wheeler by Warrant dated the 30<sup>th</sup> January 1775.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February 1833, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twelfth day of May 1907.
