



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for Everhart Michael of the County of Lancaster of a Certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in the General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Seventy five containing in Breadth East and West on the North side of Blackberry Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Blackberry Street aforesaid, Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and Seventy four, Northward by Barberrry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number One hundred and Seventy Six. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 18th day of September 1773 for Casper Weitzel Esq. by Warr^t dated the 17th Instant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February 1833, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eighteenth day of May 1907.
