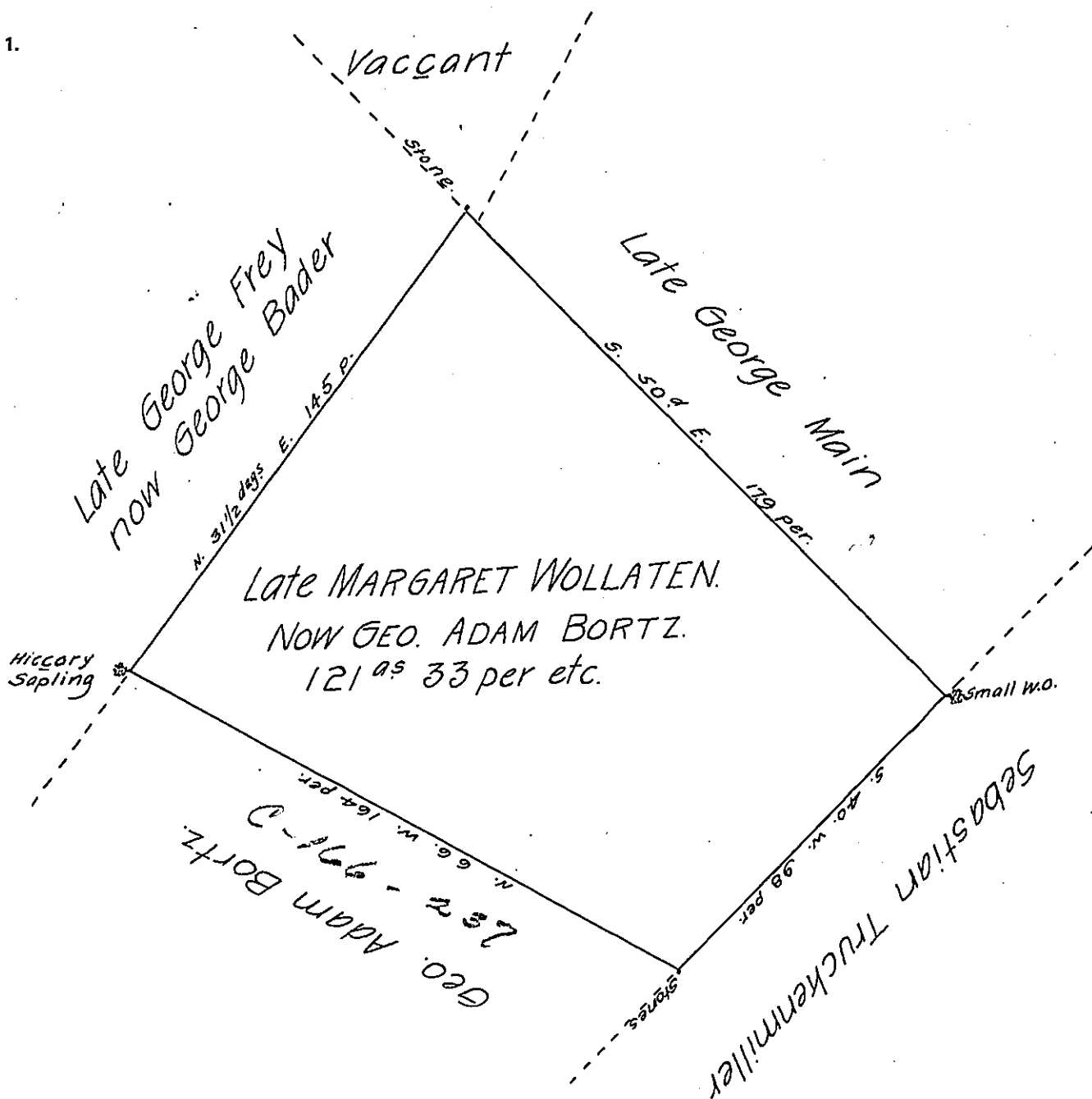


FORM No. 1.



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate the greatest part in Maccort⁶³² Township, and the Remaind^{er} in Upper Milford Township, in the County of Northampton (formerly Bucks) and Province of Pennsylvania. Containing One Hundred and Twenty One Acres and 33 Perches of Land, together with the Usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. That formerly was Surveyed By Edward Scull unto Margaret Wollaten (al. Walton) in Pursuance of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries dated June 5th Annoque Domini 1749.

The said Margaret, was afterwards married to one Casper Baker and Sold all her Right to the land to George Adam Bortz.

Resurveyed by Order of the Surveyor General on the 17th May Anno-1765.
